

ARCHAEOLOGICAL CREW CHIEF (TACOMA, WASHINGTON)

Harris Environmental Group (HEG) is looking to hire Crew Chiefs for multiple cultural resources survey projects in the Tacoma/Seattle area and surrounding locales.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

Crews will primarily be working eight day sessions, Thursday to Thursday, at 10-hours per day, followed by six days off (8 on/6 off).

Crew Leads will be responsible for leading crews of 2-4 Field Technicians in intensive pedestrian survey and site recording. Field Technicians are responsible for assisting the Crew Lead in identifying and recording cultural resources in the field. This includes identifying and documenting all types of regional artifacts and features, thoroughly filling out appropriate site forms, site/artifact photography, navigating survey transects with Garmin GPS, and mapping sites using Trimble GPS.

- Bachelor's Degree in archaeology, anthropology, or related field or completion of a field archaeology certificate program (required)
- Accredited field school (required)
- At least 12 months of supervised experience in CRM pedestrian survey (required)

- Ability to work outside in hot and cold conditions, inclement weather, and remote locations (required)
- Ability to hike up to 30 acres a day in rugged terrain while carrying up to 30 lbs. of gear and water (required)
- Proficiency with basic Garmin GPS devices and familiarity with Trimble GPS (Terrasync) (preferred)
- Skill using digital tablets for site recordation (preferred)
